

# Bible bowl chronicles

This year seven Pathfinder clubs from Iowa and Missouri competed in separate state Bible Bowls. From there the Ankeny Son Seekers, the Cedar Rapids Timberwolves, the Osceola Pathfinders, the Muscatine Mohegans, the St. Joseph Pathfinders, Kansas City's Alpha and Omega Club, and the Columbia Show-Me Club, went on to the Conference Bible Bowl in Ankeny, Iowa. At Ankeny, Alpha and Omega, Cedar Rapids and Columbia tied for first place and Ankeny took second.

These four clubs moved on to the Mid-America Bible Bowl in Lincoln, Nebraska, where Columbia and Cedar Rapids tied for first, with Cedar Rapids becoming the first Iowa Club to win first place at the Mid-America level. These two winning teams went on to Andrews University along with 19 other teams from around the United States and Canada. The Columbia team came in first along with 10 other teams and the Cedar Rapids team placed second with seven other teams.
